NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [NP] in a rule in the NOR means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. All competitors shall wear a PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing, or below deck. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. [NP]
- 1.3. RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Pac52 boats whose skipper is a member in good standing with their class association.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com, on or before 1159 Sunday 9/23/18. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1. Competitor weigh-in is scheduled from 0800-1000 9/27/18 and 0800-0900 9/28/18.
- 3.2. A competitors' briefing is scheduled for 0930 9/28/18 at StFYC.
- 3.3. The first warning signal will be at 1155, each race day.
- 3.4. Eight (8) races are scheduled; a maximum of three (3) races per day may be sailed.
- 3.5. A trophy presentation will be held as soon as possible after the last race on 9/30/18.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$400.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 1700 9/26/18 online at www.stfyc.com and at the StFYC Race Office.

6. VENUE

Racing will take place on the San Francisco Bay, west of Alcatraz Island.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. One (1) race must be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no score excluded.
- 7.3. RRS A4.2 is changed by replacing the word "series" with "race".
- 7.4. A series tie will be broken in favor of the boat with the best score in the final race; any remaining tie will be decided in favor of the owner driven boat. This changes RRS A8.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

The first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while *racing*.'

9. AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded based on participation.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this regatta. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE AT STFYC
